## INTERCESSION 2

**Lord**, we remember all those who have sought to overcome difficulties in making your Word available over recent months:

- Irish people involved in translation projects: Margaret Bohoussou, formerly from the Frosses near Ballymena, works as part of a translation team in Abidjan, the capital of the Ivory Coast. We pray that the work of her team will be richly blessed as they make the Bible text available in the languages of neighbouring countries. We ask that peace would come to Cote d'Ivoire so that Bible work would prosper and impact many lives for the Gospel.
- We pray for the people of Myanmar (Burma) who are slowly rebuilding their lives following Cyclone Nargis and we give thanks for the work of Mar Gay Shi, General Secretary of the Bible Society of Myanmar and the staff who supported humanitarian programmes and provided Scriptures to the displaced people.
- Our God, we commit to you the work that remains undone and ask that you will guide all those with resources so that they are used to meet the greatest Bible needs in our world today.
